RE: SPRING BOARD MEETING

Brothers and Sisters,

I hope this email finds you and your families healthy and unaffected by the Coronavirus/COVID-19.

Due to the mass gathering ban imposed by Governor DeWine and Dr. Acton (the Director of Public Health), the recommendation of our National FOP President Pat Yoes, consultation with our Executive Board and Counsel, and erring on the side of caution, I am cancelling the Spring Board meeting of the Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio, previously scheduled for May 8th and 9th. There are some issues that need to be addressed by the Board, such as Constitution and ByLaw changes that need Board approval 60 days prior to the Conference. Please know that the Executive Board and office staff are working to make certain we have a procedure in place to take care of the necessary business required by our own Constitution and Bylaws. I have been in contact with the leadership of the OLC Board, Ohio FOP Associates and Ohio FOP Auxiliary and have encouraged them to do the same.
