You <u>must</u> meet all of the following requirements:

Applicants for original appointment examination to the Police Department must have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years on or before the date of the written examination; furthermore, no person may apply for or receive an original appointment as a police officer if that person has attained the age of thirty-five (35) years or older, and no person can be declared disqualified as over age prior to that time. (Per ORC 124.41)

The City of Fairborn is establishing a certification list for the position of Police Officer. The following minimum qualifications must be met to apply:

- Must have high school diploma or GED equivalent
- Must be a United States citizen
- Must possess a valid unrestricted State of Ohio Operator's License
- Must possess a current State of Ohio Certification as a Peace Officer from the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) or provide proof of current academy enrollment.
- <u>Lateral Transfer</u> individuals are encouraged to apply with a minimum of one (1) year full time continuous service as a Police Officer with a political subdivision. Lateral Transfer compensation will be commensurate with experience.
- Must be physically capable of performing essential police duties and be able to
 work an 80 hour bi-weekly rotational schedule including weekends, evenings,
 nights and holidays. Must also be able to work 8, 10 or 12 hour shifts as assigned.
- Must possess the ability to successfully pass other screening tests as required prior to appointment, to include a background investigation, polygraph exam, thorough medical and psychological examination, which also includes a drug screening
