

The Port Clinton Police Department offers full testing services for the position of Police Officer through National Testing Network (NTN). To register with NTN and schedule a test, go to_www.nationaltestingnetwork.com select 'Find Jobs', then select 'Law Enforcement Jobs' and sign up for Port Clinton Police Department.

All candidates must take the Frontline National exam through National Testing Network prior to August 22, 2022.

When you visit the www.nationaltestingnetwork.com website:

- Complete the NTN registration process and schedule your test.
- Review all information related to the Port Clinton Police Department -Police Officer, including minimum requirements, salary and benefits.
- Review detailed information about the testing process.
- Review the Frequently Asked Questions and take the online practice test (if desired).

Upon completion of your scheduled exam, scores are automatically forwarded to the Port Clinton Police Department. Candidates who attain a passing score on the entry exam will be placed on the Port Clinton Police Departments eligibility list. The Port Clinton Police Department will contact candidates on the list and will invite them to participate in further stages of the selection process.

National Testing Network is a service provided to conduct entry level testing in a standardized, professional environment. National testing Network does not replace the Port Clinton Police Department's responsibility and decision making in the testing process. All candidate results are provided to the Port Clinton Police Department where the final decisions are made.
