Hiring Patrol Officers



Wages and Benefits:

- Eight hour shifts – five days on, two days off
- 2023 Base salary for Patrol Officers: \$49,245 (\$23.68hr) to \$69,419 (\$33.37hr)
 - Longevity Pay
 - Annual college degree bonuses up to \$500 per year
- Annual holiday bonuses up to \$400.00 for each holiday worked
- Physical fitness bonus of up to \$400 per year
- Annual clothing allowance of \$900 & practice ammunition provided
- All uniforms and equipment provided
- College tuition up to \$3,000 per year
- Two to five weeks paid vacation per year
 - Vacation begins date of hire
- Two personal days per year, with opportunity to earn an additional three per year (5 total)
- Earn and save up to 96 hours of Compensatory Time
- 120 hours of paid sick leave annually, with no maximum balance
- Up to 5 days paid funeral leave in the event of the passing of a loved one

Applicant Requirements:

- 21 years of age on or before the date of the written examination
- Valid driver's license
- High school diploma or GED
- Citizen of the United States of America (or legally declared intention of becoming a U.S. citizen)
- *Ohio Peace Officer Certification not required*

Obtain application online (cityofgreenville.org) or in person from the Mayor's office (100 Public Square, Greenville, Ohio 45331). Applications must be completed and submitted to the Mayor's office by 4:00pm on April 12, 2023 to be eligible for testing.

Written and physical fitness testing will be held at the Greenville High School, 100 Greenwave Way beginning at 8:00am on April 22, 2023.
